Academic Year 2014-15

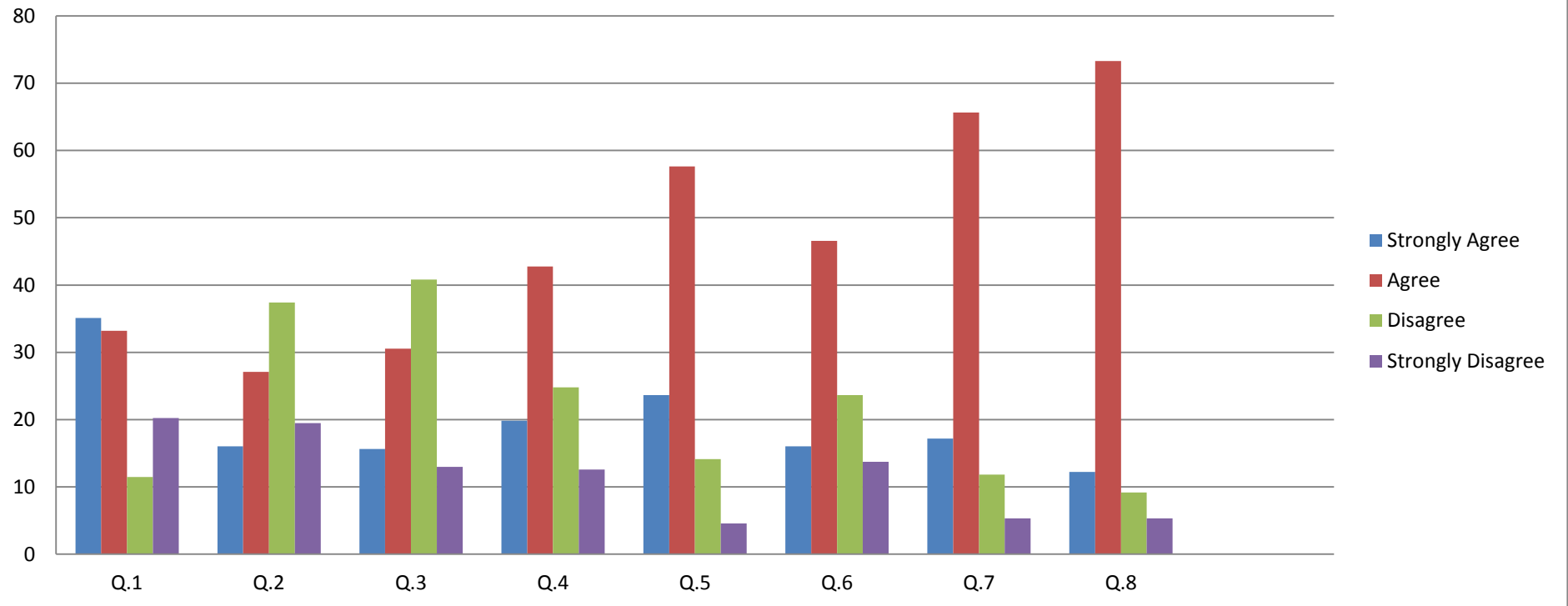

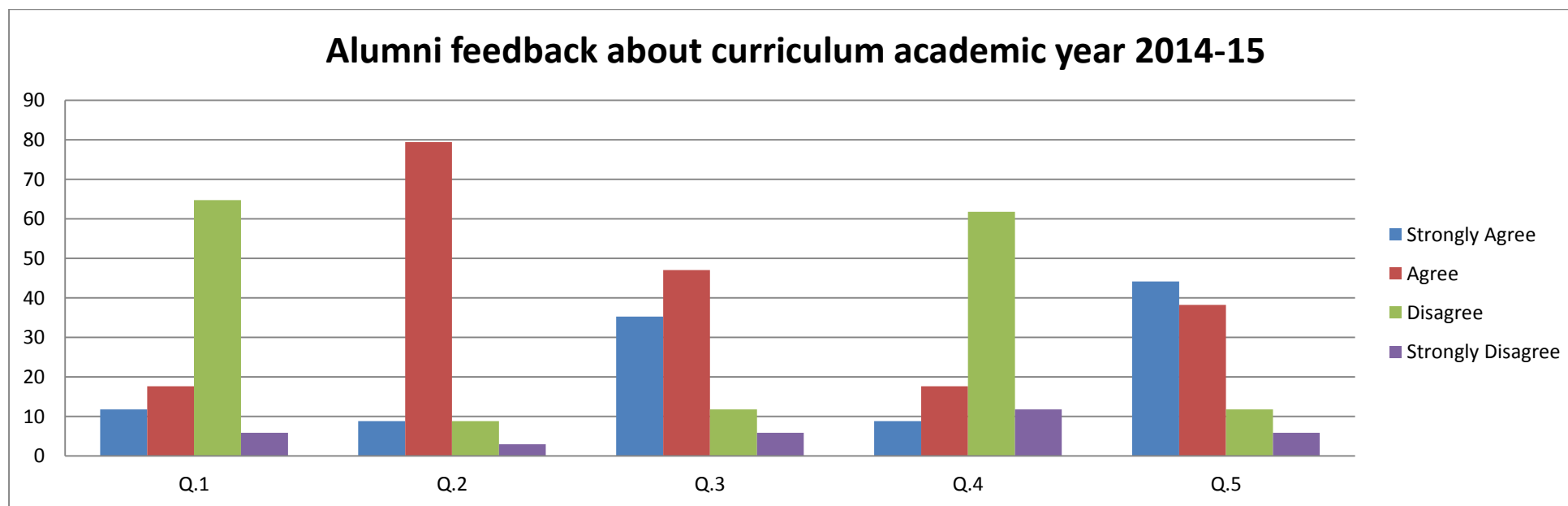

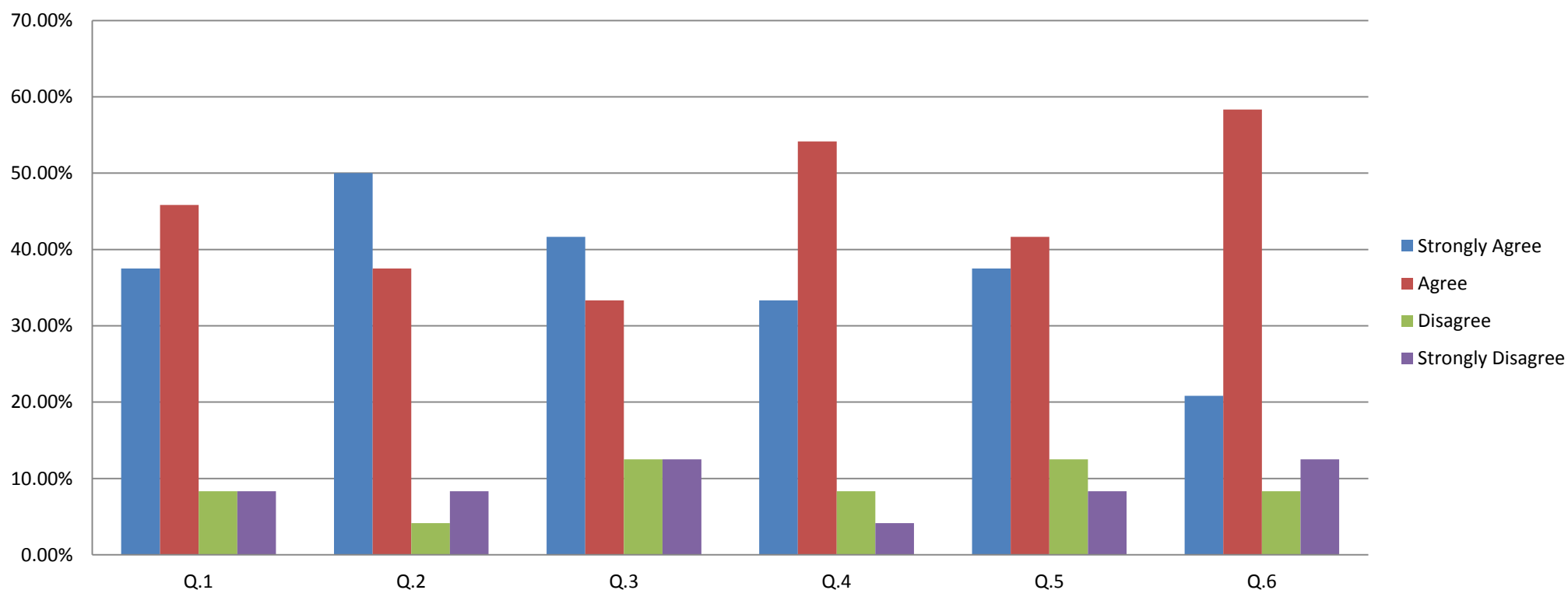
