Academic Year 2017-18

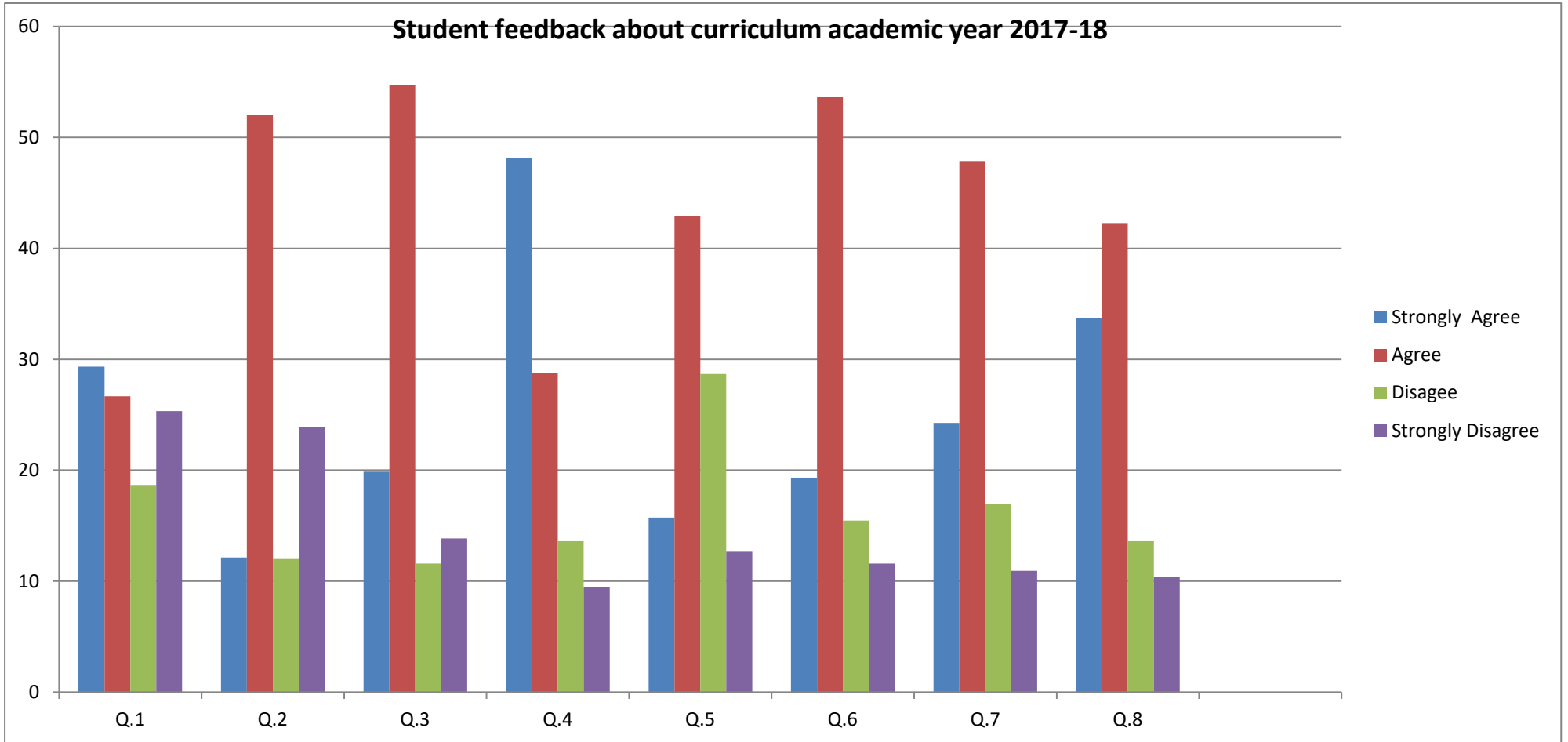

Student's feedback about curriculum

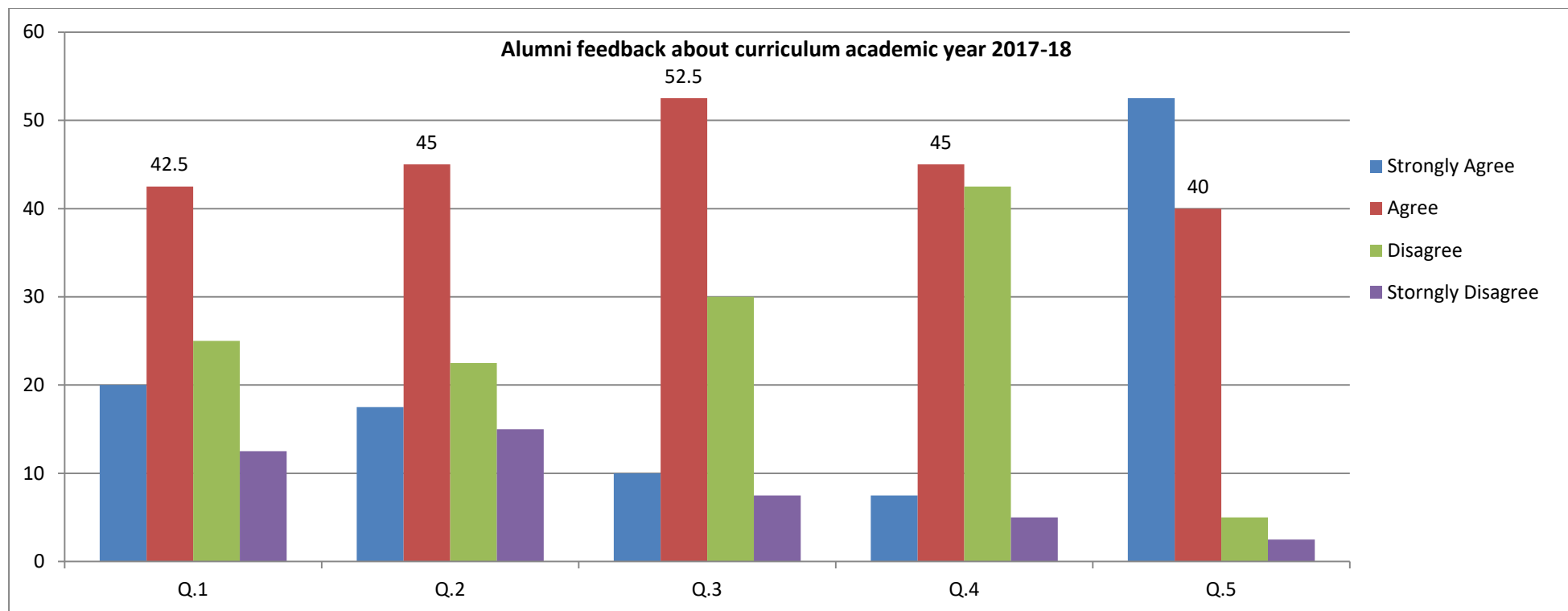

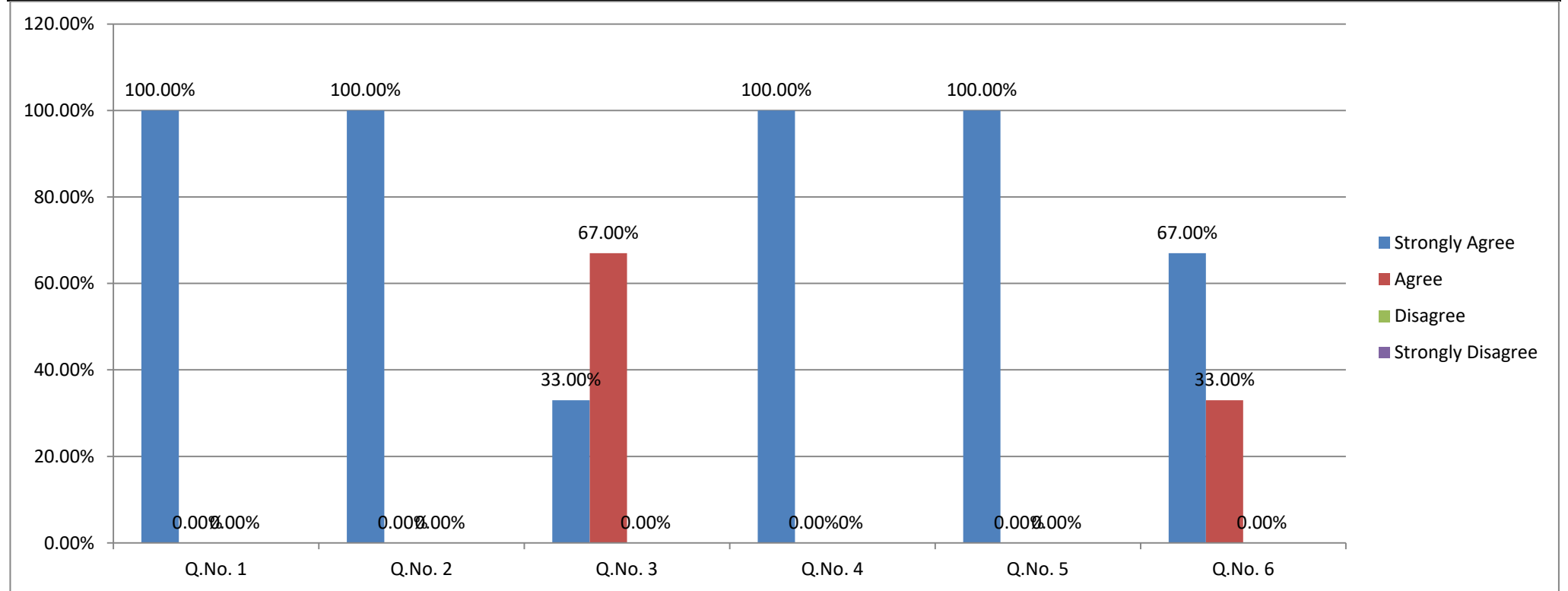
